### Safeguarding your Business

PCI Compliance was developed by the major credit card companies as a guideline to help organizations that process card payments prevent credit card fraud, cracking and various other security vulnerabilities and threats.

Any company processing, storing, or transmitting payment card data must be PCI compliant or risk losing their ability to process credit card payments and being audited and/or fined. Merchants and payment card service providers must validate their compliance periodically.

We will have Chris Deegan, a Security Product Specialist with Cisco Systems, here to discuss PCI Compliance and inform you on how you can safeguard your business.

There is no fee to attend.
