EIT South is a division of EIT, Inc. This division, celebrating its third anniversary, was created to provide EIT with long-term growth potential in a labor-rich environment. The parent company, founded in 1977, is an engineering and electronics manufacturing entity with two plants in Northern Virginia. The Danville, VA unit has a modest engineering team to compliment its cable and wire harness assembly, precision machining and sheet metal fabrication, and printed circuit board assembly operations. Michael Duncan, EIT South's General Manager, will provide an overview of the company, its capabilities and a brief overview of "why Danville."
