"Luna nanoWorks Division, Nanotechnology to Commercialization"

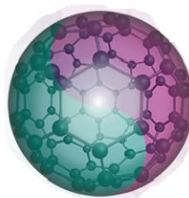

Nanomaterials are components that enable engineering at the atomic scale. The assembly of composites using this technology requires a degree of miniaturization and control of processes not possible in typical manufacturing.

The division is focusing on materials manufacturing and the development of proprietary products based on carbon nanomaterials.
